- including method of participant selection
- rationale to determine sample size

Research design, e.g. factorial, single subject, etc.

Methods, detailed overview of all procedures including subject selection, randomization

Details of statistical or other analysis

Dissemination of results

Detailed budget (including timelines, if applicable)

Sustainability plans, details of plans to sustain the new research/service/program once it

has been developed

Other avenues of funding

Regular updates/progress reports

Final report deadline

Applications will be reviewed on an ongoing basis. Please allow six (6) weeks for a response. Applications will not be reviewed during July or August.
